Playing Conditions

The President's Cup is a Stableford competition over 18 holes. The competition will respect all R&A and Local rules. Full BBGS handicaps are applicable as determined by the Handicap Secretary. No 'gimmie' putts are permitted at any time. Please keep up with the pace of play, if you cannot score, pick up.

You will be issued a scorecard on arrival which must be exchanged with one of your playing partners prior to teeing off. It must be signed by both player and scorer and submitted at the end of the round. We have a fully computerised scoring system so the scorecards must display your gross score for each hole. Failure to produce properly completed and signed scorecards will result in disqualification.

The winner of the **President's Cup** will be the BBGS member with the highest Stableford score over the 18 holes. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by count-back.

Cost

The total cost is £40 per member and £45 per guest. This includes golf, lunch and dinner. This is payable immediately. Fines

All participants in BBGS competitions are subject to a tariff of fines. All proceeds from these fines are added to our charity fund. The fines are 50p every time you are bunkered, take an air shot or get your ball wet (i.e. lakes and ponds, rain does not count); £1 for lateness, being improperly dressed or failing to pass the Ladies tee. Fines are administered by the honour system so please confess and cough up at the end of your round.

Attire

Please observe usual golf course clothing requirements. Shirts must have a collar, at least short sleeves and must be tucked in at all times. Shorts must be tailored and of traditional length. Golf shoes must be worn on the course. Denim is not permitted.

In the clubhouse, smart casual attire is required. Golf shoes, headwear and waterproofs are not permitted. No spiked shoes or caps may be worn in the clubhouse but shoes must be worn (i.e. not socks only or bare feet).
